MEN'S LEAGUE STARTUP PLAN FOR 2021

Men's league will start up on Wednesday, May 5, 2021 (pending provincial covid rules)

League dues - \$55 for the season

- Weekly prizes will be awarded along with an occasional surprise. Meals or snacks are not included.
- We will have deuce pots (\$1/par 3, birdies win the pot for that hole) each week and would like members to prepay the pot as per last year. This year we suggest you prepay your fees (\$45) along with league fees.
- Your deuce pot fee will be subtracted from your initial pot for the weeks you play.
- Hole-in-one insurance will be included with free drinks delayed until the clubhouse opens.
- Men's League members should provide their payment of up to \$100 depending on what they opt for to the Treasurer at calabogiemens@gmail.com via e-transfer (preferred). The account is auto deposit so no security question is required. You can also deposit a cheque made out to Calabogie Men's League in a sealed envelope in the allocated basket in the pro-shop. Make sure your name is on the envelope. We would prefer to not handle cash.

Tee Times

- Will begin at 9:30 am on Wednesdays – no shot gun start until further notice.
- An e-mail will go out from the Captain each week (Thursday). Please reply by Friday verifying if you are playing the next Wednesday.
- If it is make your own foursomes – advise the Captain who is in your group.
- The Captain will set the tee times and notify members of their times and groups on the Monday.

Covid Rules

- Cart use is 2 per cart. Mandatory masks if not from the same household even with divider. Mask mandatory when approaching the Bunker Bistro.
- There is a covid action plan posted at the Proshop for your reading pleasure.

- Proshop will be temporarily closed, service is provided through the open window right of the door.

Notes

- We will have regular games with foursome prizes and a deuce pot but no individual hole prizes to avoid touching markers.
- Score cards will be completed by one person in each group and deposited in the basket in the pro-shop. Once the Clubhouse opens score cards can be given to the Captain there as well.
- Clearly mark deuces and tally your scores for the game. If you forget to drop it off, take a picture and e-mail it to the Captain (bobhlomas@gmail.com).
- The Captain will send out an e-mail announcing the winners but prizes will not be awarded until social distancing rules are relaxed – or at end of season.
- A weekly update of winners will be provided including for deuce pots.
- Deuce pot winnings will be allocated across the foursome that had the deuce for those that have paid into the deuce pot fund. Winnings can be paid out via etransfer, applied to future deuce pot payments, or held in trust until a future convenient date to pay out winners.
- No tailgate parties are allowed in the parking lot, players must leave promptly following the completion of their round.
