MEN'S LEAGUE 2021

Thankfully, the 2021 golf season is fast approaching. The golf course is opening this Tuesday, March 23. Below are the details for this year's program. Please note that some elements are subject to provincial and Highlands COVID regulations/guidelines.

Start Date

- The Men's league will start up on Wednesday, May 5, 2021.

Membership Dues

- \$55 for the season.
- Meals or snacks are not included.
- We will have deuce pots each week. For members who choose to participate in the deuce pot, please prepay \$45 along with your league membership. Your deuce pot weekly fee (\$4) will be subtracted from your initial pot-payment for the weeks you play. Deuce pot winnings will be allocated across the foursome that had the deuce, for those that have paid into the deuce pot fund, and added to your pot. Your pot balance will be paid out at the end of the season.
- Hole-in-one insurance is included in your membership dues. The insurance provides a jug for every foursome playing that Men's day.
- Members should provide their payment of up to \$100, depending on what they opt for, to Terry Dort (calabogiemens@gmail.com) via e-transfer (preferred) or deposit a cheque made out to Calabogie Men's League in a sealed envelope in the allocated basket in the pro-shop. Make sure your name is on the envelope. We would prefer to not handle cash. Payments should be made before the end of April.

Tee times

- Will have a staggered start beginning at 9:30 am – no shotgun start until permitted by Highlands and provincial regulations.
- The Captain will inform the Pro Shop of the number of carts required each week. Please indicate if you need a cart when you register for golf.
- The Captain will set the tee times and notify members of their times and groups on the Monday.

Scorecards

- Score cards will be available in the Proshop with details of the game for the day.
- Scorecards should be completed by one person in each group and deposited in the basket in the pro-shop. Clearly mark the names of players in your group – especially if there are last minute changes.
- Clearly mark deuces and tally your scores for the game. If you forget to drop it off, take a picture and e-mail it to the Captain (Bobhlomas@gmail.com).

Weekly Games

- We will have weekly games with foursome prizes and a deuce pot but no individual hole prizes to avoid touching markers. The schedule for the year is on the Calabogie Highlands web-site.
- About every fourth game is make your own foursome but for the remainder of the games the groups will be set by the Captain. New members have found this a great way to get to know their fellow golfers. One of our goals is to have you play with every other member at some point during the season.
- All of the Wednesday competitions will be handicap-based and therefore we encourage everyone to join Golf Canada and maintain an up-to-date handicap. If you are a Highlands member, the Golf Canada registration is included with your membership. If you are not a Highlands member, the Proshop will register you with Golf Canada. The fee is \$49.95 and includes insurance against things such as club damage, golf cart accidents and window replacement. If you do not register with Golf Canada a handicap will be assigned to you by the captain.
- An e-mail will go out from the Captain each week (Thursday) announcing the winners including deuce pots and requesting you to confirm, by Friday, if you are playing the next Wednesday. The Captain will then e-mail you with your group and tee time on Monday.
- If it is make your own foursomes – advise who is in your group.
- Prizes will not be awarded until social distancing rules are relaxed – or at end of season.
- No tailgate parties are allowed in the parking lot.

Game May 5

- The game for May 5 will be 6-6-6 (team net score/best ball/scramble). We will begin the season with a staggered start beginning at 9:30.
- You are welcome to submit your own teams. If you want to play and are not in a foursome please inform me and I will make certain you are matched with some great guys.
